Biography

Estate Planning and Trusts

Paul designs comprehensive estate plans that preserve wealth and reflect each client's unique values and intentions. His work includes wills, revocable and irrevocable trusts, credit shelter and marital trusts, dynasty and incentive trusts, supplemental needs trusts, and advanced planning tools such as grantor retained annuity trusts and qualified personal residence trusts. He also advises on business succession strategies and entity structuring through LLCs, partnerships, and corporate recapitalizations.
